

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The Atlantic Capesize Index rose by 257 points week-on-week to 2,850 points and is now 970 points below the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate and the fronthaul rate for 180 kdwt vessels have both shown some improvement, climbing to 5-week highs of \$2,500/day (a weekly gain of \$1,500/day) and \$7,000/day(+\$1,000/day w-o-w), respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
