

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After rising for eight consecutive weeks, the Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 258 points to 3,962, which is 428 points below the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate for 180kdwt vessels dropped by \$2,500/day from last week's 7-month high to the current level of \$8,750/day, while the fronthaul rate fell by \$1,750/day week-on-week to \$15,250/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
