

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell for a second consecutive week to 3,833 points. The index is now more than 1,200 points below the year-ago level. However, the fronthaul rate climbed by \$1,250/day week-on-week to \$16,500/day.
