ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

This week saw a small gain of 158 points in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to 3,991 points. However, the index is still some 567 points below the year-ago level. Atlantic round voyage rate rose by \$1,250/day to \$8,750/day. It was a quieter week for fronthaul trade, with rates only climbing by \$500/day week-on-week to \$17,000/day.
