

## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index was up 33 points last week to 3,822 points. The index is now 673 points below the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate edged higher by \$250/day to \$7,000/day. However, there was a weekly decline of \$1,500/day in the fronthaul rate to \$12,500/day.
