ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index was down by 218 points last week to a 10-week low of 3,684. The index is now 1720 points below the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate and the fronthaul rate for 180 kdwt vessels both fell to their lowest levels since mid-April at \$5,250/day (a weekly decline of \$1,000/day) and \$12,000/day (-\$500/day), respectively.
