## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

After falling to 10-week low last week, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index edged up by 107 points to 3,791. The index is now 1,911 points below the year-ago level. The fronthaul rate for 180 kdwt vessels rose by \$1,000/day last week to a 4-week high of \$13,000/day, while the Atlantic round voyage rate was up marginally to \$5,300/day.
