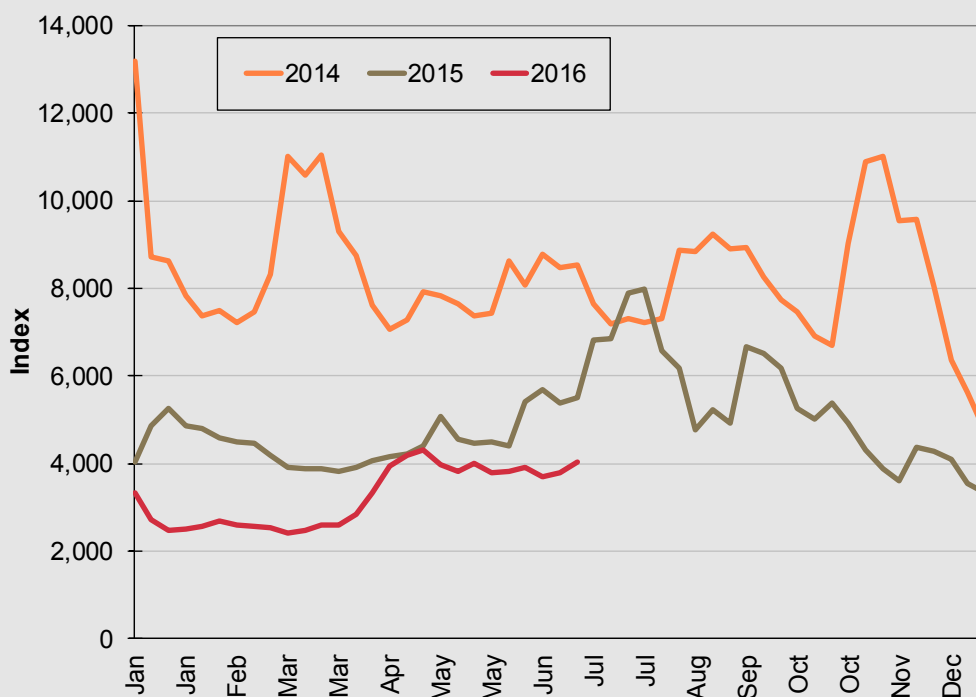
This week saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rebound to a 9-week high of 4,030 points. However, the index is still 1,337 points below the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate for 180 kdwts vessels climbed by \$950/day last week to \$6,250/day, supported by increased chartering activity, while the fronthaul rate rose by \$850/day to \$13,850/day, a level last seen five weeks ago.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
