ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose by 118 points week-on-week to the highest level since the end of October 2015 at 5,060 points. However, the index is still more than 1,600 points below the year-ago level. Atlantic round -voyage rates and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) both increased to their highest levels since end-April, at \$9,250/day and \$17,000/day, respectively.
