MARKET COMMENTARY

Bulkers: China is closed for business (1st to 7th October), celebrating the "National Day Golden Week". After a sluggish start early in the week, the BDI increased to 921 points today, boosted mainly by cape index rally (BCI jumped by 206 points on Thursday alone). Twelve ships changed hands this week at improved levels as asset values are firming (1 kamsarmax, 5 ultramaxes, 1 supramax, 3 handymaxes & 2 handies).

Demolition: Subcontinent is showing the money to container ships as we recorded levels well in excess of \$300 per lt. As the container market is in dire straits, more ships built well into the 2000's (such as the "Viktoria Wulff" built 2006/Poland) are expected to be heading for recycling. We heard today that even a 2009 built container vessel is quoted for scrap to cash buyers this week. Further discussions with prominent cash buyers, we understand that bulkers also started to attract offers in the region of \$300 per lt, however we have not recorded any sale at this levels yet. Bangladesh is low-balling as it has almost reached full capacity and is concentrating in larger tonnage basis November delivery. Turkish market has softened while China is on holidays this week.
