ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose for a third consecutive week to a 15-month high of 7,291 points, up 550 points week-on-week. The index also marks the largest annual increase (+3,698 points) since March 2014. Atlantic round voyage rates (180k dwt) increased by \$3,750/day last week to \$24,750/day, while fronthaul rates rose above \$30,000/day for the first time since August 2015, with a weekly gain of \$4,000/day.
