After reaching a 15-month high last week, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 947 points to 6,344. However, the index still marks a large annual increase of 1,982 points. Atlantic

annual increase of 1,982 points. Atlantic round voyage rates for 180 kdwt vessels fell sharply by \$6,500/day last week to \$18,250/day, while fronthaul rates were down \$8,750/day at \$21,500/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
