ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has begun 2017 at 6,086 points, up by 196 points from 23 December. This is 2,742 points above the year-ago level. The current fronthaul rate of more than \$19,000/day compares with approximately \$12,000/day at the beginning of 2016. The Atlantic round voyage rate has climbed by over \$1,000/day since the end of 2016 to \$14,545/day, which compares with a year ago level of close to \$7,000/day.
