ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

After rising for three consecutive weeks, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index softened 414 points to 5,764. However, the current index is still well above the corresponding levels in the previous two years. Furthermore, rates were starting to firm again by the end of last week. The fronthaul rate (180 kdwt) of \$18,750/day compared with \$21,250/day at the previous week, while the Atlantic round voyage rate fell by \$2,400/day to \$12,950/day.
