## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

The Simpson Spence Young Atlantic Capesize Index was down marginally by 13 points last week to 4,503. However, this is still 1,935 points above the year-ago level. Steady volumes of chartering activity in the Atlantic basin were reported, with round voyage rate (basis 180 kdwt) climbing by \$500/day week-on-week to \$6,500/day. Fronthaul rates edged higher by \$150/day to \$13,000/day.
