ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After falling for four consecutive weeks, the Simpson Spence Young Atlantic Capesize Index rebounded 523 points last week to 5,026, the largest weekly gain so far this year. Increased chartering activity in the Atlantic pushed round voyage rate (basis 180 kdwt) to a four-week high of \$10,000/day, up by \$3,500/day last week, while fronthaul rates rose by \$2,500/day to \$15,500/day.
