After rising for six consecutive weeks, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index declined by 774 points last week to 6,679 points. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (basis 180kdwt) dropped by \$3,750/day to \$16,500/day, while fronthaul rates fell sharply by \$4,100/day from last week's 2017-high to \$28,150/day.
