The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has recovered some of the ground it lost last week, rising by 234 points week-on-week to 6,913 points. The Atlantic round-voyage rate increased by \$1,250/day to \$17,750/day, while at \$29,500/day the fronthaul was up by \$1,350/day. Nevertheless, both remain below the year-to-date highs achieved at the start of April.
