ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 787 points week-on-week to 6,126 points. With slower iron ore volumes and a build up of ballasters off the coast of Brazil, Atlantic round voyage rates and fronthaul rates both fell to six-week lows, dropping by \$4,750/day to \$13,000/day and \$4,500/day to \$25,000/day, respectively.
