THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Tanker owners are keeping a close watch on OPEC production policies and yesterday's announcement that OPEC and its allies are extending oil production cuts for nine more months may not be a good sign for tanker charter rates during the 2nd half of 2017 and maybe 2018. Last year's agreement has failed to eliminate the global oversupply or achieve a sustained price recovery in the price of oil. OPEC together with Russia and other non-members agreed to prolong their accord through March, but no new non-OPEC countries will be joining the pact and there was no option set out to continue curbs further into 2018. The market was unimpressed as prices tumbled more than 5% to under \$49 a barrel in New York and more than a billion barrels were traded.

Crude and clean tanker charter rates are about the same as a year ago and have recovered somewhat from the lows of end 2016, however for the past couple months they have been on a downward trend.


Dry cargo freight rates continue to ease and the BDI dropped another 5% this week to close at 912 (high for 2017 was 1338 two months ago). Fewer high capital ships are trading hands and prices appear to be softening, particularly on older bulk carriers.


