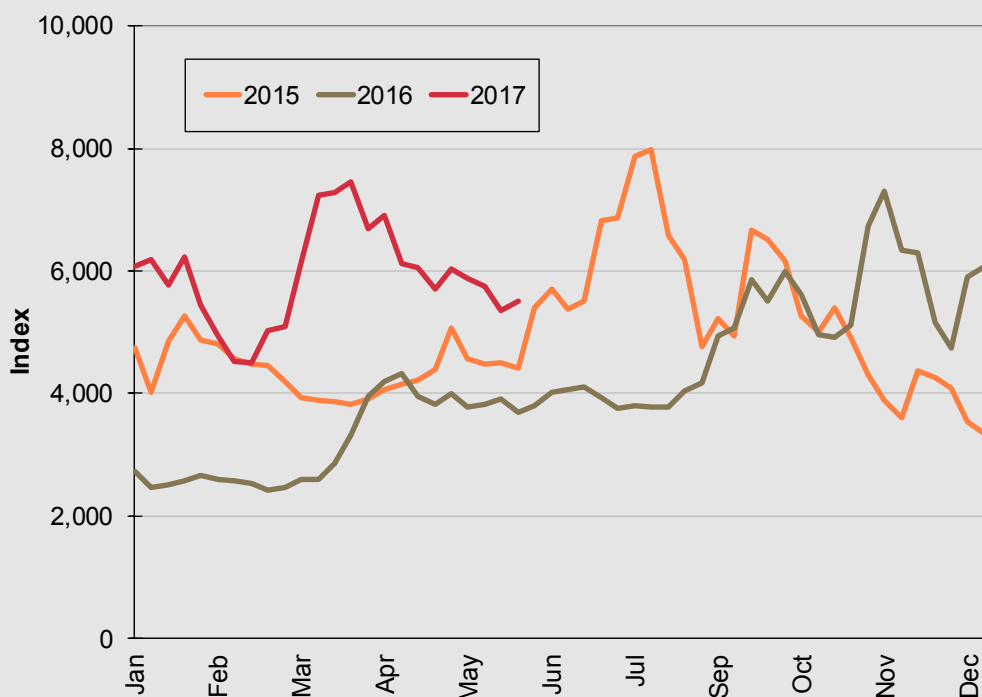
After falling for three consecutive weeks, there has been a 135 point week-on-week gain in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to 5,498 points. Some upward movement has returned to rates in the Atlantic due to healthy levels of chartering activity. The Atlantic round voyage rate for 180 kdw vessels rose by \$2,600/day to a three-week high of \$9,850/day. There was a \$1,150/day increase in the fronthaul rate to \$21,000/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
