THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Prima Marine of Thailand completed a \$157 mill. IPO in Bangkok this week and will use most of the proceeds over the next three years to buy nine tankers of 3-10,000 DWT plus eleven tankers from 14,000 DWT to VLCC's. They will also purchase four floating storage units and two FSO's.

Large newbuilding orders continue to grab headlines. This week it was reported that the Vale newbuilding replacement program for 320-365,000 DWT VLOC's is moving forward rapidly and that they have booked as many as 30 ships so far. The Brazilian mining company is replacing about 50 aging VLOC's that had been converted from VLCC's with shallow draft newbuilding's built to the IMO Tier III emissions standard. Vale invited a handful of major ship owners to tender against long period COA's and deliveries are expected towards the end of 2019 with estimated cost of region \$75 mill. each.


Toyota Motor is reportedly spending excess \$1.8 Billion to update their PCTC car carrier fleet (currently own about 25+ units built prior to 2010). Japanese owners K Line, NYK, and Toyofuji Shipping will build about 20 x 7,000 car capacity vessels which will be LNG powered and backed by long term charters to Toyota.




