ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 146 points week-on-week to 7,588 points. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) fell by \$2,650/day week-on-week to \$30,000/day due to a lack of fresh cargoes. Meanwhile, the Atlantic round voyage rate dropped by \$1,700/day to \$19,150/day after reaching a year-to-date high in the previous week.
