
The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 692 points week-on-week to 7,716 points as a slower fronthaul market contributed to a softening of earnings in the basin. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) fell by \$5,750/day to \$28,250/day, while there was a \$3,750/day decline in the Atlantic round-voyage rate to \$17,750/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
