ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index was down by 167 points week-on-week to 7,893 points. The fronthaul rate for 180kdwt vessels retreated by \$500/day last week to \$30,000/day due to a weaker Brazil market. However, there was a further gain in Atlantic round voyage rates, edging up by \$500/day to \$20,750/day.
