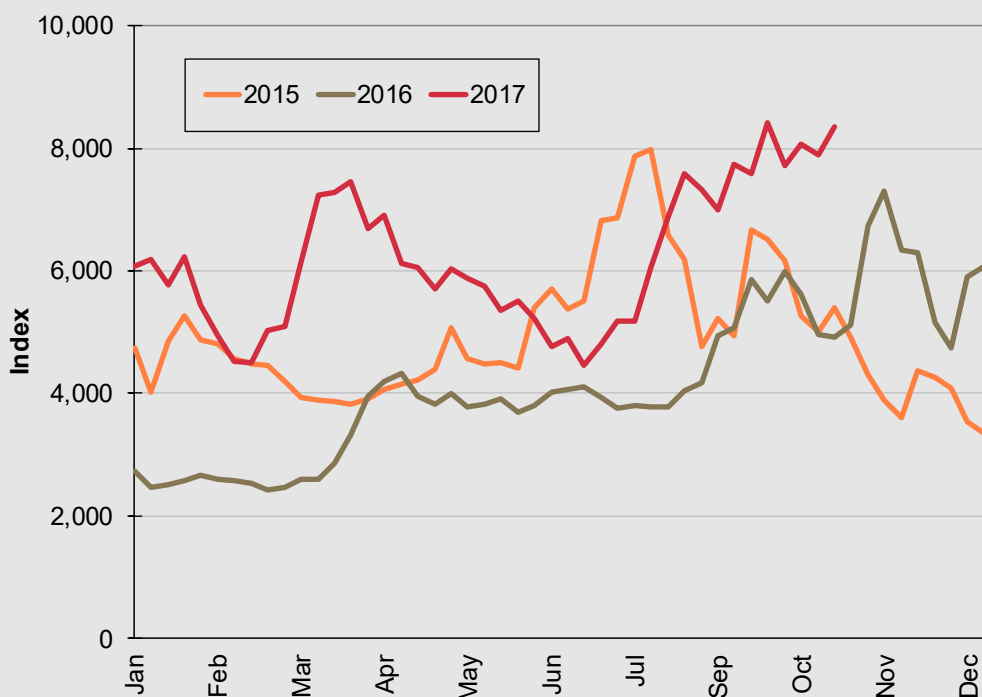
Supported by strong trans-Atlantic coal and iron ore chartering, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed 452 points week-on-week to 8,345 points, regaining the losses of the week before. The round-voyage rate (180k dwt) increased by \$4,250/day to \$25,000/day, while the fronthaul rate rose by \$3,000/day to \$33,000/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
