The Pacific market pauses for breath after the increases of the previous five weeks, with the SSY Pacific Capesize Index retreating by 229 points to 5,674 points. The Pacific round-voyage rate for a 180 kdwt vessel fell by \$2,750/day to \$19,000/day, while the W.Australia-China iron ore spot rate slipped \$0.40/t last week to \$7.75/t.
