#### THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Two weeks ago we mentioned the short supply of ship finance that has opened the door for Chinese leasing companies. Last week we highlighted how the departure of traditional lenders from the shipping markets has provided opportunities and availability for credit funds to offer alternative ship finance (with larger advances and correspondingly higher spreads).

One of our readers mentioned last week that we should comment about how there has been a surge in shipping finance getting done in the Norwegian Bond Market and this week it has been reported that U.S. based shipping companies OSG and Eagle Bulk are currently exploring deals in the Norwegian Bond Market.

Shipping companies are increasingly heading to Oslo to find bond financing and so far in 2017 we have seen Odfjell, Hough LNG, Teekay LNG Golar LNG, GasLog, Euronav, Ship Finance, Teekay Shuttle Tankers, Songa Bulk, Stolt Nielsen, Wallenius Wilhelmsen Logistics, MPC Container Ships, Borealis Maritime and Fjord1 ASA raise well over \$2 billion YTD in this market. These deals have been marketed globally to institutional investors participating from the United States, UK and Asia as well as the Scandinavian regions.

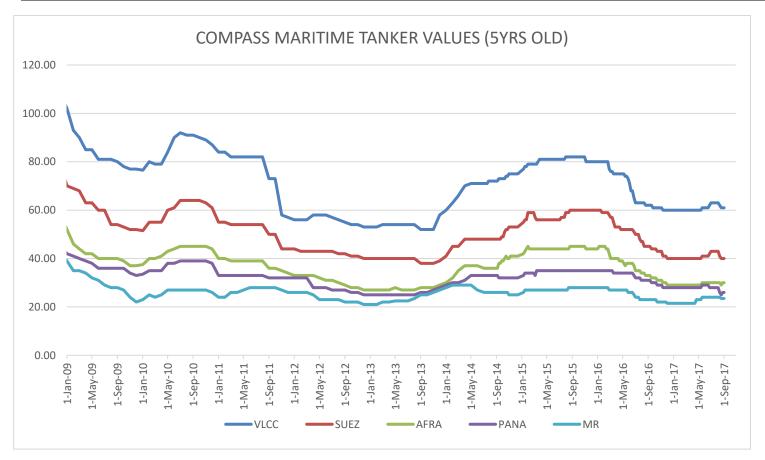
The Nordic high-yield market (particularly in Norway) ground to a halt after the 2014–2015 oil price crash. However, as most problematic cases have been restructured, interest has returned to new deals. Investor appetite has been boosted by international conditions with still-supportive monetary policies and tightening credit spreads. Funds have yet again experienced inflows, supporting increased activity in the primary markets. Consequently, issuance recently exceeded \$12 billion YTD, with the previous record of \$12.9 billion looking to soon be history.

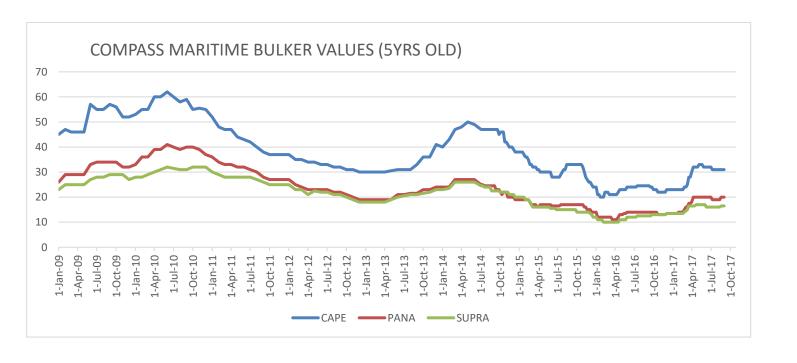
