The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index regained upward momentum following the slight fall of the previous week to reach its highest level of the year, up by 617 points to 8,894. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) rose by \$2,500/day to \$34,500/day. There was also a weekly increase of \$2,350/day in Atlantic round voyage rates to \$25,350/day.
