ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

There was a more substantial upward movement in the Atlantic, with the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index standing above 10,000 points for a second consecutive week. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) jumped by \$5,500/day to \$37,000/day, while there was also an increase of \$3,600/day in the fronthaul rate to \$43,250/day, the highest level since mid-November 2014.
