THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

The BCI index moved slightly lower at the end of the week after leading the dry cargo charter rate rally upwards for the past month (the BDI closed at 1371 on November 17th and finished at 1619 today). However, bulk carrier buying sentiment is still strong and prices remain firm.

Despite the start of the holiday season (and usual slowdown) continues in the dry bulk side of the public shipping markets. 2020 Bulkers of Norway (Tor Olav Troim Group) went public on the Oslo over-the-counter market on December 4th at about \$2/share and has already more than doubled in value to about \$4.35/share. The company has 2 x NewCastlemaxes on order at \$44.2 mill. each and they have an option for 6 more sisters at \$44.7 mill. each.

It has been reported that a major U.S. dry cargo public shipping company has purchased their 12th bulk carrier since starting their fleet renewal program after restructuring in 2015. The vessel is reported to be the Ultramax bulker M/V "ESSENCE OF SEATREK" (63,500 DWT/Built 8/2015 at Yangzhou Dayang SB in China) and the price is reported to be in the region of \$21.5 mill.


Scorpio Bulkers of Monaco (48 vessel fleet) has filed a registration for a mixed shelf offering targeting up to \$500 mill. The company may periodically offer common shares, preferred securities, debt securities, warrants, rights, purchase contracts and units. Scorpio confirmed that they have recently acquired ten vessels including 6 x Ultramaxes from Golden Ocean, three Ultramaxes from Greathorse in Hong Kong, and a newbuilding resale Kamsarmax from Jiangsu New Yangzijiang Shipbuilding in China which is scheduled for delivery in the 2nd quarter of 2018.




