ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After surpassing 10,000 points for two consecutive weeks, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 1,206 points last week to 9,373. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) fell by \$7,250/day to \$29,750/day, while there was also a sharp weekly decrease of \$8,000/day in the fronthaul rate to \$35,250/day.
