

WEEKLY SHIPPING MARKET REPORT WEEK 2

WEEK 2 (5th Jan to 12th Jan 2018)

<u>Market Overview</u>

It is notable, how the Chinese domestic freight market has slowed down by over 25% in the last month and one of the consequences we have witnessed is the halt to the buying spree by Chinese import buyers of older Handymax and Panamax. Of course, the imminent Chinese new year holidays may be a factor behind a slow down, but for now the bonanza has stopped. However, owners of old tonnage shall be encouraged by the rapid increases in the demolition market where we have seen a capsize bulker sold at just under 500 usd/ldt last week.

The crude tanker markets continue to disappoint despite the extreme cold conditions in the USEC and we expect to see more older VLCC's come for sale in the recycling market.

Bulkers

In the capesize sector M/V Cape Med – 185,827 Dwt / 2006 Blt Japan sold at \$ 20.6 mill , while around December was as sold the quite smaller M/V Kerkis sold at \$ 22.5 mill , interesting will be to follow up the sale of the 2 year older M/V Bulk India which is currently under negotiations , M/V Bulk India was falsely reported as sold back in October at \$ 15.2 mill.

Moving on the handymax sector the vintage M/V Rong Hai – 46,601 Dwt / 1995 Blt Japan sold to Chinese buyer at \$ 4.5 mill .Through auction sold at 9th January the M/V Trading Fabrizia – 34,529 Dwt / 2011 Blt Korea which was lying at Kingston ,Jamaica with her class suspended for more than 1 year to clients of Bluefin based in Greece at \$ 10.3 Mill , we heard that the vessel received 13 offers. M/V Atlantic Ace – 28,671 Dwt / 1999 Blt Japan sold to Chinese buyers at \$ 4.75 mill. Another future sale which will be of interest is M/V Orient Sunrise – 28,514 Dwt / 2001 Blt Japan the vessel will be inspectable the forthcoming days around 16 January at China, as we are hearing that 11 parties showing interest to proceed for inspection.

Tankers

The 2 Lr1 M/T King Darius & King Duncan – 73,700 Dwt / 2007& 2008 Blt China sold to Greek Buyers at en bloc basis around \$ 28.0 mill while one week ago we have seen reported the one year older Lr1 M/T Advance Victoria sold at \$ 13.5 mill.

 $\rm M/T$ High Freedom – 49,990 Dwt / 2014 Blt Korea to clients of D'amico at \$28.0 mill basis 10 year BB with purchase option in the end. A fleet with 13 small stainless steel tankers sold to Germans clients of John T. Essberger.

Demolition

Even though we are in the second week of the year, a lot of sales have been concluded. During the last weeks, Pakistan sales on BC reduced but there are positive feelings, after also the impressive sale of M/V Enterprise – Ldt 20,437 at tremendous price of 495 usd/ldt. As you will notice from the sales below, Indian market pays for every type of vessel from BC to Reefers with 13 vessels concluded this week including 8 Tankers mostly MR's but also 2 Aframax, all for undisclosed prices. The Reefer Gibraltar – LDT 19.623 achieved 467 usd/ldt. Meantime, Indian and Bangladeshi buyers competed between each other for the 2 MR Tankers Norte & Breeze – LDT 9.407 & 8116 which sold for 460 usd/ldt each with still unclear destination. Although Bangladesh is not that much active, continues to attract vessels from the wet market but of bigger tonnage like the 2 Suezmax MT Vito – LDT 22.257 & M/T Symeon - LDT 24.901 that concluded for 400 usd/ldt and for undisclosed price respectively.

DRY BULK COMMENTARY

WEEK 2 (5th Jan to 12th Jan 2018)

Capesize

West Australian iron ore rates into China continued in the mid/high usd 6.00's pmt range during **Week 2**. Brazilian iron ore into China also continued at low usd 17.00's pmt levels. Trips via Australia in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range. One year's period employments continued rating in the usd 19,000/20,000 pd range.

Kamsarmax/Panamax

Trips via Indonesia and Australia into China and India can fetch anything from usd 9,000 pd to usd 12,000 pd. South American grain trips into the Far East continued in the usd 14,000/15,000 pd range plus a usd 450/500,000 ballast bonus. US Gulf fronthaul trips in the usd 15,000/16,000 pd range plus a usd 500/600,000 ballast bonus. Intercontinental trips in the low/mid usd 13,000's pd range. Period employments have been rating in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range.

<u>Ultramax / Supramax</u>

Chinese trips into Southeast Asia with steels or fertilizers are rating in the usd 6,000/7,000 pd range. Round nickel ore trips via the Philippines in the usd 7,000/8,000 pd range. Round iron ore trips via Indonesia are being offered in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range. Indian fronthaul trips are being offered in the usd 9,000/10,000 pd range. Indian backhaul trips with steels at low usd 6,000's pd for the first 50/60 days and low/mid usd 8,000's thereafter. South African fronthaul trips are rating at low usd 12,000's pd levels plus a usd 200,000ish ballast bonus. Usd 16,500 pd for a Black Sea fronthaul basis delivery in the Mediterranean on a Supramax. Usd 14,000 pd for a West African bauxite trip into the Black Sea on a Supramax. Usd 23,500 pd for a US Gulf fronthaul on an Ultramax. Ultramaxes are seeing short/long period proposals in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range.

Handymax / Handysize

Handysize trips have been generally rating in the usd 7,000/8,000 pd range both in the Atlantic and the Pacific basins. Usd 14,000 pd for a South American trip into the Baltic. Usd 15,500 pd for another South American trip into West Africa. No period activity to report here.
