

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index was down by 601 points this week to below the 8,000 mark for the first time since mid-October 2017, but remains 2,209 points higher than the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) declined by \$3,500/day to \$24,250/day, while there was a smaller weekly decrease of \$1,150/day in the fronthaul rate to \$34,350/day.
