ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

A sharp dip in rates pushed the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to a five-month low of 6,697 points, down by 1,276 points from the previous week. As a result, the premium to the year-ago level has been reduced to 469 points. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) has declined by \$9,400/day to \$14,850/day, while fronthaul rates fell by \$10,000/day to \$24,350/day. Both rates have dropped to their lowest levels since early August 2017.
