ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After falling to a five-month low last week, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rebounded by 128 points from the previous week to 6,825. The premium to the year-ago level climbed to more than 1,300 points. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) rose by \$800/day to \$15,650/day, while fronthaul rates rebounded by \$1,500/day to \$25,850/day.
