ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index softened by 487 points from the previous week to 6,338, the lowest level since early August. However, the premium to the year-ago level remained at 1,400 points. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) dropped by \$4,900/day week-on-week to a sixmonth low of \$10,750/day, while fronthaul rates fell by \$3,450/day to \$22,400/day.
