A fourth successive weekly fall has put the SSY Capesize Pacific Index at a nine-week low of 3,953 points. The Pacific round voyage rate (180k dwt) edged \$200/day lower last week to \$11,300/day, while the West Australia-China iron ore spot rate was barely changed, at \$6.15/t.
