## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

Led by gains on trans-Atlantic routes, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose by 287 points week-on-week to 5,282 points. Nevertheless, it remains more than 1,600 points below the year-ago level. The fronthaul and Atlantic round-voyage rates (180k dwt) increased by \$1,650/day and \$900/day to \$19,150/day and \$5,150/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
