ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has climbed back above the 8,000 points mark for the first time since the second week of January, rising by 681 points week-on-week to 8,004 points. Gains were strongest on trans-Atlantic routes in the north of the basin where tight tonnage supply pushed up earnings. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) rose by \$4,350/day week-on-week to \$19,500/day, while there was a \$1,500/day increase in the fronthaul rate to \$33,000/day.
