ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index edged slightly higher week-on-week to 8,079 points. With Brazilian and East Coast Canadian iron ore shipments still constrained, earnings increases appear to reflect a reduction in the availability of spot tonnage within the basin, rather than an increase in cargo volumes. The round-voyage rate climbed \$350/day to \$19,850/day, while the fronthaul rate rose by \$150/day to \$33,150/day.
