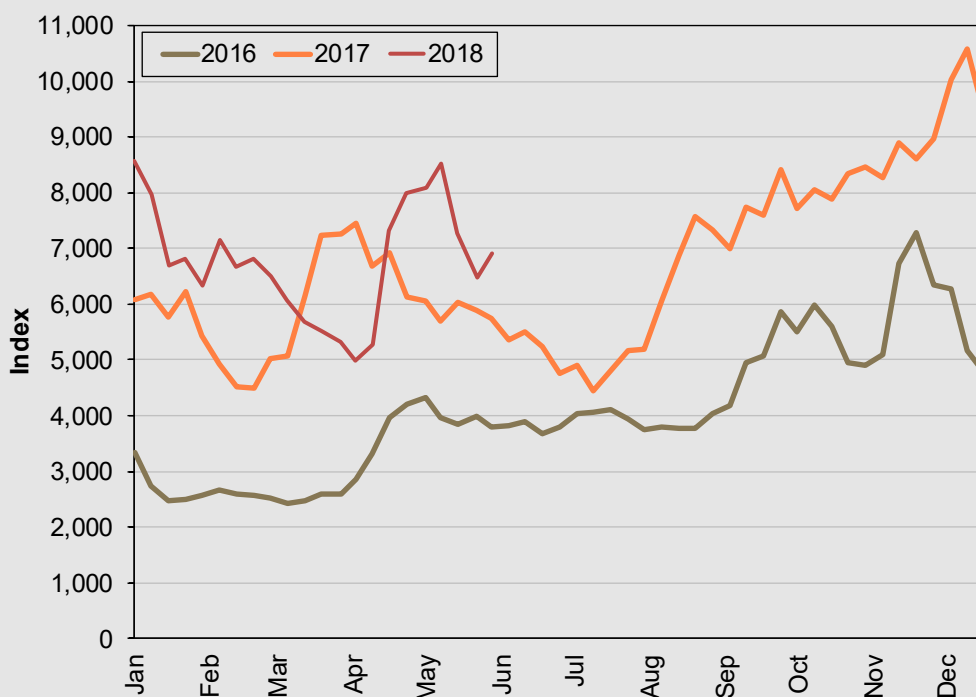
After two weeks of decline, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has returned to growth, rising by 436 points week-on-week to 6,911 points. Supported by Brazilian iron ore and West African bauxite, the fronthaul rate (180k dwt) rose by \$2,350/day to \$24,350/day, while the Atlantic round-voyage rate increased by \$1,500/day to \$11,250/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
