

# WEEKLY SHIPPING MARKET REPORT WEEK 24

WEEK 24 (8th Jun to 15th Jun 2018)

### **Bulkers**

Ceres Shipping have sold their capesize bulker "Red Cherry" 182/2015 JMU to undisclosed buyers for USD 45 mill. The deal is understood to include a nine-month charter at \$18,000 per day.

Lomar Shipping have disposed their supramax "Ocean Prefect" 53/2003 Oshima, with SS/DD 07/2018 to Chinese Buyers for USD 9.1 mill. Please note the one year older "Navios Achilles" 52/2002 Sanoyas was sold for USD 8.3 mill.

Polforce Shipping have sold their supramax "Agia Eirini" 50/2001 Mitsui with DD 17/11/2018 to Chinese buyers for USD 8.5 mill. Please note that the "Jin Fu" 50/2001 Oshima with DD 04/2019, was sold two months ago for USD 8.7 mill.

Japanese controlling company have sold their handysize bulker "King Wheat" 33/2009 Shin Kochi with SS/DD 06/2019, to clients of Orient Shipping for USD 11.9 mill. Note that the "Elliott Bay" 32/2009 Kanda Zosensho with SS/DD 01/2019 was sold two months ago for USD 11.7 mill.

Japanese Owners have sold their handysize "Prinsesa Sirena" 28/2011 I-S with DD 11/2018 to Greek buyers at levels USD 9.8 mill. The one year older "Glorious Sentosa" 28/2010 I-S with DD 06/2018, was sold previous month at levels USD 9.5 mill.

#### **Tankers**

In the Newbuilding sector, Navios have reportedly signed an LOI for 2 x VLCC tankers scrubber-ready at Imabari.

In the second-hand sector, we had the en-bloc sale of the "Sti Milwaukee" 49/2014, "Sti Tribeca" 49/2015, "Sti Seneca" 49/2015, "Sti

Bronx" 49/2015, "Sti Manhattan" 49/2015, and the "Sti Battery" 49/2014 all built Hyundai Mipo Korea were sold to Chinese owner, CMB Leasing, for an undisclosed price.

### **Demolition**


After Poseidonia festivities, subcontinent buyers are back to start filling up shipyards. The forthcoming monsoon season and religious holidays are puting a push to the buyers. Pakistan has reduced a bit the offering prices due to currency depreciation, while Bangladesh and India are firming up, as well seems to be gaining ground in the large sized tankers competition.

### DRY BULK COMMENTARY

WEEK 24 (8th Jun to 15th Jun 2018)

#### **Capesize**

Week 24 has seen rates on the West Australia / China iron ore route ranging in the mid/high usd 7.00's fio. Round trips on the same route are being reported in the usd 17,000/18,000 pd range. Rates for Brazilian iron ore into China have been reported in the low/mid 19.00's fio range. Usd 35,000 pd for an Atlantic fronthaul. Period employments have been rating in the usd 20,000/23,000 pd range. Usd 25,000 pd for a 2 years employment basis delivery in the Pacific.

#### Kamsarmax/Panamax


North Pacific round trips have been rating in the mid/high usd 11,000's pd range. Indonesian round trips with coal in the usd 12,000/13,000 pd range. Australian rounds in the low/mid usd 14,000's pd range. Usd 22,000 pd for a Mediterranean fronthaul. Usd 12,500 pd for a Mediterranean round trip via the Black Sea. Intercontinental trips in the low/mid usd 13,000's pd range. South American grain fronthauls continued rating in the usd 15,000/16,000 pd range plus a usd 500/600,000ish ballast bonus. Southeast Asia delivery remains an option in the low/mid usd 13,000's pd range. Usd 17,000 pd plus a usd 750,000 ballast bonus for a US Gulf run into Pakistan. Period employments have been rating in the usd 13,000/14,000 pd range.

#### Ultramax / Supramax

A reposition fixture for an Ultramax on a steels/generals trip ex China into West Africa, at usd 9,800 pd for the first 60 days and usd 14,000 pd thereafter. Chinese steels trips into Southeast Asia and the Persian Gulf continued in the low/mid usd 10,000's pd range. Nickel ore trips via the Philippines in the usd 11,000/13,000 pd range. Indonesian coal trips into China primarily in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range basis Singapore delivery. Usd 12,750 pd for a South African fronthaul basis delivery at East Coast India. Usd 17.000 pd for a Black Sea fronthaul on an Ultramax. Usd 6.500 pd for a Continental run into the US Gulf on a Supramax. Continental scrap trips into Turkey have been rating in the usd 12,000/13,000 pd range. Usd 18,500 pd for a US East Coast trip with woodpellets into the Continent on an Ultramax. South American fronthauls in the low/mid usd 15,000's pd range plus a usd 500/550,000 ballast bonus. An Ultramax was reported for 1/2 laden legs within the Pacific at usd 13,000 pd.

#### **Handymax / Handysize**

Another quiet week for this segment. A fertilizer trip ex Persian Gulf into the Red Sea has been offered at usd 8,000 pd. Usd 11,000 pd for a South American trip into the Mediterranean. Usd 8,400 pd for a South American coastal. No period activity to report here.






