Supported by fronthaul iron ore chartering from Brazil and Canada, coupled with coal shipments from the US East Coast, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed 423 points week-on-week to 8,331, over 3,100 points above the year-ago level. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) increased by \$2,750/day to a five-week high of \$33,750/day, while there was a \$1,700/day rise in the Atlantic round-voyage rate to \$19,200/day.
