

WEEKLY SHIPPING MARKET REPORT WEEK 29

<u>Bulkers</u>

Greek based Golden Union Shipping have sold two of their Capesize "Malena" & "Cic Trias" 180/2016 Hanjin, to USA buyers clients of Genco Shipping at levels USD 49.0 mill each. Profitable asset placement strategy by the Greek owner as they bought both vessels back in January 2016 for a price of USD 35.3 each mill.

Kamsarmax "Rena" 82/2011 STX was sold via auction to Derby Maritime for USD 18.75 mill.

Japanese owners Nisshin Shipping have committed two of their modern Kamsarmaxes "Hanton Trader V" & "Hanton Trader VI" 81/2015-16 Hantong, to Chinese buyers at levels region USD 24.4 mill each. Note, that about two months ago the "Ocean Forte" 81/2015 Guangzhou Longxue was sold at levels USD 23.8 mill.

Synergy Marine Group have sold their Panamax "Lady Maria Ocean" 76/2007 Imabari with DD 2/8/2018, at levels mid USD 13 mill to undisclosed buyers. In comparison, the one year younger "Toro" 76/2008 Imabari with DD 12/2020, was sold previous week at levels USD 15.25 mill.

Taiwan Navigation have committed their Panamax "Tai Plenty" 73/2000 Sumitomo with DD 09/2018, to Chinese Buyers for low USD 8 mill. In addition, the one-year younger sister ship "Omiros" 73/2001 Sumitomo was sold a month ago for USD 8.8 mill.

Vrontados have committed three of his Handy bulk carries "Kaity L" & "Christina L" & "Maria L" 50/2003 blt Jiangnan ("Maria L" SS/DD due) to Chinese Buyers for USD 8.5mill, USD 8 and USD 8 mill respectively. The vessels previously failed to Chinese Buyers earlier this month at mid USD 8 mill probably due to the new Chinese regulations.

<u>Tankers</u>

We understand that AISSOT, a joint venture between Iraqi Oil Tankers and Arab Maritime Petroleum Transport, have purchased two VLCC resales built at Samsung from BW Maritime with delivery in 2019 for USD 88 mill each. Note, the vessels are not scrubber fitted.

Japanese based Nissen Kaiun have sold their VLCC "Bright Harmony" 309/2009 Imabari to Greeks clients of Andros Maritime for USD 41.5 mil.

Scorpio Commercial Management have sold one Aframax and six MR2 tanker to undisclosed buyers including a 7 Years BBB with purchase option from year 3 onwards and purchase obligation at end. Subject tankers are the foll: "Sti Alexis" 115/2015 Daehan | "Sti Yorkville" & "Sti Duchessa" 50/2014 HMD | "Sti Mayfair" & "Sti San Antonio" & "Sti Benicia" & "Sti St Charles" 50/2014 SPP.

D'Amico have sold their MR tanker "High Trust" 49/2016 Hyundai Vinashin to Japanese Buyers for USD 29.5 mill including 10 years bareboat back to D'Amico.

Demolition

In India, steel plate prices and demand fell even more this week. The Bangladeshi demolition market is currently the lead market between the three major demo markets.

DRY BULK COMMENTARY

WEEK 29 (13th Jul to 20th Jul 2018)

Capesize

A rather indifferent week in terms of chartering activity for the larger ships which lost their steam and turned negative in the middle of the week but managed to close positive today. Rates on the West Australia / China iron ore route for Week 29 have more or less remained steady fetching around usd 8.50/mt whereas Dampier/Qingdao voys managed to secure usd 9-9.10/mt on Friday. Aussie-Nopac rounds were reported at the end of the week at \$21,500/d-\$22,000 bss S.Korea dely/Spore-Japan redely. Rates for Brazilian iron ore into China were reported in the high usd 21.00's-low usd 22.00's range. There was not much appetite for period employment this week as negative indexes kept Charterers away from fixing vessels for short/long period.

<u>Kamsarmax/Panamax</u>

Another quiet week on the Indonesia/China coal route, with the majority of Charterers continuing to rate in the usd 7,500/8,500 pd range. Slightly better numbers on the Australia/China route, in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range. North Pacific round trips have been rating in the usd 12,000-12,500 pd range for Kamsarmax vessels. A 74000 dwt (2001 blt) vsl fetched 11,000/d bss dely dop WCI for a trip via ECSA with Spore-Japan redely. A number of South American grain fronthauls were also reported in the high usd 15,000's / usd 16,000 pd range plus usd 580/600,000 ballast bonus. Transatlantic rounds were concluded at \$16,000/d for Kamsarmaxes. One year period employment is worth US\$14,000/d for a modern Kamsarmax bss dely in China and One year plus one year in chop was reported today at \$15,750/d for a 2018 Kmax vessel.

<u>Ultramax / Supramax</u>

Atlantic Ocean continued to pay better numbers for this sector with a modern Ultra getting \$17,000/d bss dely Miss River for a trip to Turkey. A Smax (2004 blt) vessel was fixed at \$14,000/d for a similar trip with same dely (Miss River) to West Med. Conti trips to feast with grains were fixed at \$19,900/d for modern Ultramax vessels. A Conti/Turkey scrap trip was reported at \$11,000/d bss dely in Belfast for a 53k Dwt Smax vessel. A trip from Canakkale/Bsea to USG is worth \$10,000/d for the first 45 days and \$14,500/d thereafter for an Ultramax vessel. A Smax vessel opening in Algeria achieved \$12,500/d for a trip to W.Africa with clinker. S.Africa/Spore-Japan trips are worth around \$12,800/d plus \$280k bb bss aps dely. Indonesian coal trips into China and Southeast Asia have been concluded in the usd 10,000/10,500 pd range basis Southeast Asia delivery. India direction continued at more or less last week levels of abt usd 10,500-11,000/d. No period activity to report here ..

<u>Handymax / Handysize</u>

A generally quiet week for the smaller vessels. A 37k dwt vsl was reported fixed at \$9,500/d bss Canakkale dely for a trip to Egypt which is a good improvement from last week's levels. Not much seen in the Pacific Basin and no period activity to report for handy/handymax vessels.
