The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index slipped 222 points last week to 9,798 points as an excess of tonnage caused trans-Atlantic rates to soften. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) fell by \$4,100/day to \$25,000/day, while there was a \$750/day decline in the fronthaul rate to \$42,000/day. Nevertheless rates remain seasonally strong.
