ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

For the first time since 2014 the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has held above 10,000 points for the third consecutive week. The small weekly decline in the index to 10,159 points came as the Atlantic Round Voyage rate decreased \$1,850/day to \$25,650/day and the fronthaul adjusted downwards by \$200/day to \$42,500/day.
