ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

A fourth consecutive weekly decline saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index drop to 9,064 points, down by 537 points week-on-week. Reduced Brazilian iron ore chartering contributed to a \$2,450/day fall in the fronthaul rate (180k dwt) to \$37,350/day, while the Atlantic round-voyage rate declined by \$3,425/day to \$20,000/day.
