ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has retreated to the lowest level since June at 8,524 points, down by 540 points week-on-week. It has now fallen by more than 2,100 points since the start of August. The round-voyage rate (180k dwt) declined by \$4,000/day to \$16,000/day while there was a \$1,850/day drop in the fronthaul rate to \$35,000/day.
