Supported by an active North Atlantic fronthaul market, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index edged 77 points higher week-on-week to 7,952 points, although this was still down year-on-year. There was a \$2,400/day increase in the fronthaul rate (180k dwt) to a three-week high of \$36,650/day and a \$500/day rise in the Atlantic round-voyage rate to \$12,350/day.
